

Satellite Info (updated Oct 2011)

How it works: The incoming artist contacts the outgoing artist approximately the last week of his/her exhibit. They schedule a day to change the walls. Please, no walls empty for more than 1 day! If you have a problem, please notify Laura Culver (518-5116, laura@lauraculver.com) so that she can find a solution before the location becomes peeved. If a location is not reserved, and there is only one month left before it goes empty, then Laura will seek a guest artist to fill the spot. Artists are welcome to sign up for a 2-month show at any location except Starbucks Tam Junction. Also, please do not sign up for more than 1 month per calendar year at Starbucks Tam Junction.

Before setting up your installation, please review the hanging system & preferences of your location (see list below). You may need to bring the following items: a step-stool, hammer, extra hooks, pliers. You are welcome to post a resume, but in some cases it must be hung from a cable or hook, as we have locations that do not allow tape/putty on their walls. Stacks of postcards, business cards and window displays etc are generally not welcomed by the locations unless they are contained in a wall-mounted dispenser.

Artisans will take 25% if a member's work sells, and 40% if a guest artist's work sells. Sales are handled directly by the artists, who should have their contact information easily available at their show. If you sell something, please send 25% to the Artisans P.O, Box and note the month and the location from which it was sold.

Alain Pinel Realtors: Open 10-4 every day. 30- or 60-day exhibit is fine. This location holds an artist's reception (Mill Valley First Tuesday Artwalk). Be prepared to bring a few beverage/wine & snack items. Confirm with Bernard that a realtor will have door unlocked on the evening of your reception. Your name will be printed in the Artwalk program. Work hung by wall hooks/nails ... okay to make new holes. Have not asked about nudes yet. Putty on walls okay so far.

CMCM (Community Media Center of Marin): Open Tues-Fri 2pm-8pm and Sat 12-4. This is a large space with dramatic spot lighting, holds 18-25 works. Good for large work. They welcome artist receptions, so if you want one, just work with Michael Eisenmenger. The center teaches filmmaking, editing and other film related skills. They are responsible for 2 local TV channels. Michael is sometimes approached by outside artists. I've marked "own artist" to reserve a some months for him.

Double Rainbow: Open Mon -Thur 9am-11pm, Fri 9am-12am, Sat 10am-12am, Sun 12am-11pm. 30- or 60-day exhibit is fine. A casual Café with mostly a lunch or ice cream/coffee clientele. Recommend you don't hang small work in back - a theft occurred a few years ago. Work hung by wall hooks & nails. Putty on walls okay. Although nudes have been allowed in the past, this might change. You should ask Charlie or Joanne specific permission in advance of each show, just to cover yourself (pun!).

Frank Howard Allen: Open 10-4 every day. 30- or 60-day exhibit is fine. This location holds an artist's reception (Mill Valley First Tuesday Artwalk). Be prepared to bring a few beverage/wine & snack items. Confirm with Andy that a realtor will have door unlocked on the evening of your reception. Your name will be printed in the Artwalk program. Work hung by wall hooks/nails ... okay to make new holes. Nudes okay. Putty on walls okay.

Miracle Mile Cafe: Open 8 am to 3 pm every day. 30- or 60-day exhibit is fine. Holds 12-15 works. There's room for some large work, especially horizontals. They are located in what used to be a Sushi restaurant, near the McDonald's on the "miracle mile." Work hung by wall hooks/nails ... okay to make new holes. No nudes please. Putty on walls okay.

Royal Sweet Bakery: Open M-F 6:30-6:30, Sat 7:30-5:30 and Sun 8:30-4:30. Work hung by wall hooks/nails ... okay to make new holes. No nudes. Work is visible to sidewalk, so pedestrians will often stop in to get a closer look. Putty on walls okay.

Starbucks (Tam Junction): Open M-F 5am-7pm, Sat 5:30am-7pm, Sun 6am-6pm. Work hung by cables. Don't attach **anything** to walls. No price tags allowed on art - put pricing on your bio. Prefer art changed after 3 pm (to avoid busy coffee time). Bring a 6 ft. ladder in case an s-hook pops out of the rail. Bring a 7 ft. ladder if you want to adjust the lighting. No nudes. They don't like being disturbed so don't ask for any supplies, like extra wires, hooks etc. This is not the most hospitable location, but sales have been good in the past ...

YMCA Hamilton: Open Mon-Thu 5:30am-9pm, Fri 5:30am-7pm, Sat-Sun 7am-1pm. Art hangs in nice and clean front lobby area. It's in a renovated hangar at the back of Hamilton. There is a green 6 ft. ladder you may need, to adjust hanging cables. There is always a front desk person, so the work is very secure. This location is good for diverse sizes from 8x10 to 36 x 48. Putty on walls is okay. Prefers no nudes.
